Description of Work Performed: Trans-Tel was awarded a \$67,000+ EFI&T contract to install new underground fiber optic cable and associated infrastructure for upgrade of existing network services to the Absentee Shawnee Tribal Health Clinic campus buildings. Work included boring approx. 2,000 feet of conduit, installing 10 new hand holes with marker poles, three BET building risers, approximately 3,000 feet of new 24-strand single-mode fiber optic cable.

This work effort concluded ahead of any contractual period of performance date with no damaged utilities or disruptions in service. Trans-Tel tested and certified the installed cable and delivered the successful results package, as well as a CDRL "as built" drawing package, to the customer upon completion.
