In September 2019, Trans-Tel Central LLC partnered with Sumaria Systems to win the award of a \$1,300,000+ contract (#2607) to provide redundant fiber optic backbone communications capability to facilities in the munitions storage area and multiple buildings circumnavigating the active flight line at Homestead ARB, FL. These three separate contract line items involve installation of underground communications infrastructure between two Information Transport Node buildings and 36 end buildings in support of the USSOUTHCOM contingency, training and air combat mission of the 482<sup>nd</sup> Fighter Wing.

The project as a whole has Trans-Tel tasked with engineering, furnishing, installing and testing 19 new maintenance holes; 20,653' (3.9 miles) of bore, trench and new conduit; 22,190' (4.2 miles) of new textile inner duct; 71,925' (13.62 miles) of new fiber optic cable; and 1,552 fiber splices and terminations.

Kick-off is expected to begin in January 2020, and is anticipated to be completed by 20 Aug 20.
