Description of Work Performed: Trans-Tel was awarded a \$24,000+ contract to perform project efforts under the Mentor-Protégé program with Takbox E2 of the Delaware Tribe. It involved the installation of a new access control, intercom and intrusion system for the Pawnee Agency offices.

The efforts included the coordination with the incumbent fire alarm contractor personnel to integrate the access control system with the fire alarm system to maintain the schedule.

Trans-Tel generated and submitted all as-built and training documentation to the end users at project completion.

We have continued to provide maintenance and supplemental equipment adds since that time.
