



**TRANS-TEL WIRELESS PAST PERFORMANCE**

In March 2019, Trans-Tel Central LLC, partnered with OnX (later CBTS) to win award of a \$98,000+ contract with \$14,000+ change order (#2389) to provide wireless access to all occupied buildings on the University of Science and Arts of Oklahoma (USAO), campus wide.

The project as a whole had Trans-Tel tasked with engineering, furnishing, installing and testing 398 network cable drops; 18 pathway cores and raceways and supports for each; terminating 398 network cable drops; installing 41 customer provided network switches and 403 wireless access point antennas.

This work effort concluded well ahead of contractual period of performance date with no disruptions in service. Trans-Tel tests and certifies all installed fiber and copper cable and delivers “as built” drawings to the owner and prime contractor upon completion.
